General Behavioral Profile

KEY:

Happy = experience is enjoyable, fully tolerates, asks for more

Anxious = tolerates, but would prefer to avoid if possible, may shake, nervous, but does not attempt to growl, snap, or bite or run away.

Aggressive = persistent barking, may lunge forward, intense focus on object: owner unable to distract, may need to be muzzled for procedure, attempts to growl, snap, or bite.

Hyper = more than merely excited, may be combined with anxiety, persistent or repeats behaviors, difficult to distract.

Fearful = nervous, anxious, attempts to escape, body posture reflects dog is prepared to run away or may attempt to growl, snap, or bite, (Fight or Flight)

Neutral = no response, dog does not care

Unknown = do not know, has never been attempted or exposed
